The Environmental Technical Advisory Committee (ELTAC) will host a meeting of its subcommittee on **Artificial Intelligence (AI) use in Laboratories** as noted above.

During the December 4, 2025 meeting, and clarified during the May 19, 2026 meeting, ELTAC voted to form a subcommittee to:

- 1) Define what AI is, in the context of laboratory operations,
- 2) Establish guidelines or use tests for when AI should or should not be utilized
- 3) Draft a Recommendation to propose to the Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program for actions to take regarding AI use.

These items will go before the full ELTAC committee for a vote on any final actions.

No physical location is available. In accordance with the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act, all meetings of the subcommittee are open to the public. Government Code section 11125.7 provides the opportunity for the public to address each agenda item during discussion or consideration. Prior to ELTAC taking any action on said item. A quorum of ELTAC may be present at the public workshop but no decisions will be made until the full ELTAC meeting.
