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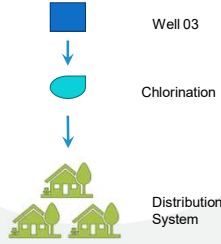
**Infrastructure: Inyokern CSD**

**Permitted Infrastructure**

- Source: Well 03
- Continuous chlorination
- Storage: Tank 1 Bolted Steel (425,000 gallons)

**Other:**

- On January 2025, Well 04 was reclassified and inactive and removed from the permit. The well continues to be inoperable and physically disconnected from the distribution system.



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**Equipment Life Expectancy**

Equipment	*Typical Equipment Life Expectancy	Age of Equipment
Wells	35 - 45 years	30 years (Well 03)
		7 years (Well 04)
Chlorination Equipment	10 - 15 years	11+ years (Estimated)
Storage Tanks	30 - 60 years	11+ years (Estimated)
Mains & Distribution Pipes	35 - 40 years	38+ years

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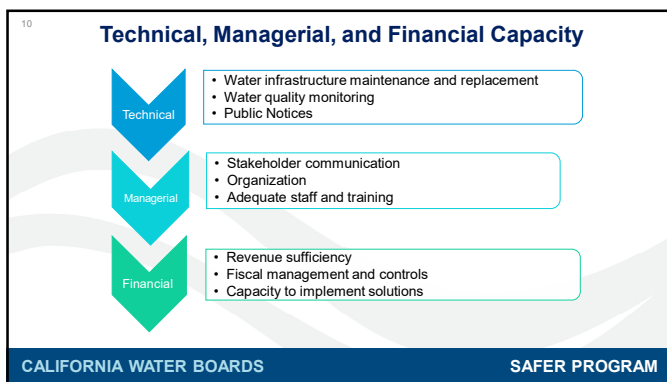
**Water System Challenges**

- On July 17, 2024, the Division issued Compliance Order No. 04\_24J\_002 for failure to meet the minimum pressure and maximum day demand capacity at all times for 2024. To date, the CSD remains out of compliance.
- The CSD is a single source reliant
- Technical, Managerial and Financial Capacity



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**Drought Planning: Senate Bill 552**

**Small Water Suppliers: All (15-2,999 connections)**

Implement drought resiliency measures, subject to funding availability:

- Detect production well groundwater levels - Jan 1, 2023
- Mutual aid organization membership - Jan 1, 2023
- Continuous operation during power failures - Jan 1, 2024
- Backup source of water supply or a water system intertie - Jan 1, 2027
- Meter each service connection and monitor water loss - Jan 1, 2032
- Meet fire flow requirements - Jan 1, 2032

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**Goals**

- Safe and reliable drinking water
- Complete necessary improvements
- Maintain community engagement
- Oversee implementation of long-term consolidation solution




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### Mandatory Consolidation – What Does It Mean?

- The State has the authority to order consolidation between two systems, includes
  - Managerial
  - Physical
- Mandatory consolidation is only applicable when:
  - The subsumed system is a disadvantaged community
  - "Documented" water quality or quantity issue
  - There is an adequate and sustainable water system nearby



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### Why is the State Board Taking This Action?

- Water Quality or Capacity Issues
- Physical Infrastructure Deficiencies
- Technical, Managerial, and Financial Issues

**The State Board has determined that Inyokern CSD has not reliably provided safe and affordable water to its customers.**

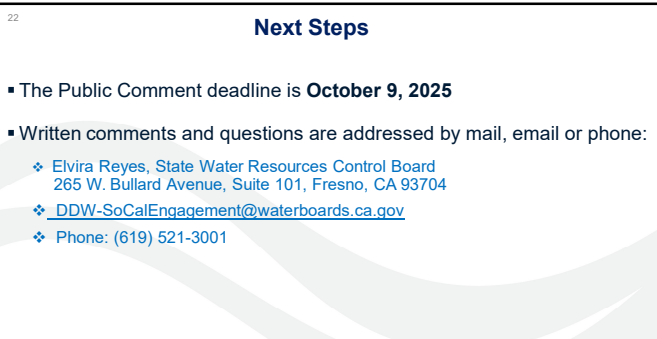
