RESOLUTION NO. R6T-2003-0013

**CONSIDERATION OF RECOMMENDED REVISIONS TO STATE WATER
RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD'S STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN LIST FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004**

WHEREAS, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region (Regional Board) finds:

1. Section 13225 (e) of the California Water Code (CWC) requires the Regional Board to “recommend to the State Board projects which the Regional Board considers eligible for any financial assistance available through the State Board.”
2. Loan assistance from the State Revolving Fund (SRF) is available to public agencies for planning, design, development, and construction of facilities for wastewater treatment, non-point source pollution reduction, storm drainage, water recycling, and other water pollution prevention projects.
3. Regional Board staff sent letters on January 16, 2003 to approximately 200 agencies soliciting preliminary applications for projects eligible for loans from the SRF program.
4. In response to this letter, Regional Board staff received a number of new preliminary applications for SRF loan funds, as shown in Table 1 (Attachment A), which is made a part of this Resolution.
5. Additionally, to remain eligible for SRF loans, uncompleted projects from the prior State Fiscal Year must be included in recommendations to the State Board. Those projects are described in Table 2 (Attachment B), which is made a part of this Resolution.
6. As need arises throughout the fiscal year, other public agencies may be interested in applying for SRF loans, making future revision to the SRF list for State Fiscal Year 2003-2004 desirable. If authorized by the Regional Board, the Executive Officer may recommend additional projects throughout the year.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Regional Board recommends that the State Fiscal Year 2003-2004 SRF list include the projects described in Table 1, in the Priority Classes and for the amounts indicated.
2. The Regional Board recommends that the uncompleted projects from the State Fiscal Year 2002-2003, as described in Table 2, be added to State Fiscal Year 2003-2004 SRF loan list.

3. The Regional Board authorizes the Executive Officer to add applicable projects to the State Fiscal Year 2003-2004 SRF loan list during the fiscal year as necessary.
4. The Regional Board directs the Executive Officer to transmit his recommendations to the State Water Resources Control Board for further funding consideration.
