Dear Mr. Zorba:

On March 20, 2015, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the in-situ groundwater remediation at the NASA Bravo Skim Pond is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs).

In the letter dated December 19, 2016, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187 because the injection of sodium persulfate and sodium hydroxide was completed in July 2015 and no additional injection activities are planned in the future. The coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187 for the subject site is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
