TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR US GYPSUM COMPANY FACILITY, 14370 GANNET STREET, LA MIRADA, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 2041700, ORDER NO. R4-2005-0030, SERIES NO. 061, CI-9176, WDR100009828)

Dear Ms. Stevens:

On September 18, 2006, Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the injection of sodium persulfate, hydrogen peroxide, and Fenton's reagents, for the treatment of groundwater at the US Gypsum Company facility in La Mirada is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2005-0030, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated April 15, 2013, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2005-0030 because the injection of chemicals for the treatment of groundwater has completed. The last injection was performed in March 2009. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2005-0030, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
