SUBJECT: ORDER OF PROCEEDINGS FOR CONSIDERATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS, TIME SCHEDULE ORDER, AND CEASE AND DESIST ORDER FOR LAS VIRGENES MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT (TAPIA WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY) ON SEPTEMBER 2, 2010

Regional Board staff received requests from Las Virgenes Municipal Water District (LVMWD)¹ and Heal the Bay² concerning the amount of time they believe is necessary for their presentations on this matter. After careful consideration of these requests, the following Order of Proceedings and time allocations will be employed at the hearing on September 2, 2010, unless the Chair makes a modification for cause.

1)	Opening Statements by Clerk/Chair and Administration of Oath by Chair	Approx. 5 minutes
2)	Regional Board Staff Presentation ³	Approx. 45 minutes
3)	LVMWD Presentation	50 minutes maximum
4)	Heal the Bay Comments	20 minutes maximum
5)	Interested Persons'/Public Comments	3 minutes maximum each
6)	LVMWD Rebuttal/Cross-Examination/Closing Statement	Limited to remaining time from LVMWD Presentation
7)	Board Questions and Deliberations	

Since Heal the Bay is not a party to this proceeding, it may not reserve time for rebuttal. Heal the Bay is encouraged to make all comments during its allocated time. Of course, the Regional Board may ask questions of Heal the Bay during Board Questions.

Questions from the Regional Board are not included in allocated time.

¹ LVMWD requested 60 minutes total, with 40 minutes allocated towards a main presentation and 20 minutes reserved for rebuttal, cross-examination of Regional Board staff, and a closing argument.

² Heal the Bay (who is not a party to this proceeding) requested 30 minutes total, with 20 minutes allocated towards a main presentation and 10 minutes reserved for rebuttal.

³ Regional Board staff is not a party to the proceeding; their participation in this proceeding exists for the purpose of advising and assisting the Regional Board.
