TERMINATING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT FOR PHILLIPS 66 COMPANY, LOS ANGELES LUBRICANTS TERMINAL ORDER NO. R4-2016-0056 (CI NO. 6773)

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board), finds:

- 1. The Regional Water Board issued Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit Order No. R4-2016-0056, for the Los Angeles Lubricants Terminal, operated by the Phillips 66 Company (Discharger). The WDRs and NPDES permit regulate the discharge of treated industrial stormwater and stormwater runoff to the Dominguez Channel.
- 2. The Discharger has now enrolled under the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) Order No. 2014-0057-DWQ, *General Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Industrial Activity,* as amended by the State Water Resources Control Board on August 4, 2015, and November 6, 2018 (Industrial General Permit). The Industrial General Permit regulates stormwater discharges from industrial facilities to surface waters.
- 3. Therefore, the individual WDRs and NPDES permit contained in Order No. R4-2016-0056 are no longer necessary and should be terminated.
- 4. The Regional Water Board has notified the Discharger, interested agencies, and persons of its intent to consider termination of these individual WDRs and NPDES permit and has provided them with an opportunity to submit written comments.
- 5. The Regional Water Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following Waste Discharge Requirements and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit be terminated except for enforcement purposes:
