REQUEST OF EXTENSION OF THE FEDERAL PERIOD FOR STATE TO ACT ON CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION FOR PROPOSED VISTA CANYON RANCH (Corps' Project No. 2012-00192-AOA), LOS ANGELES COUNTY (File No. 12-034)

Dear Mr. Allen:

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board received an application for a Clean Water Act Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the above referenced project on April 24, 2012. Because the project may impact the 100-year floodplain, and may increase chloride loadings to the Santa Clara River, the Regional Board will require more than 60 days to act on this application. As such, the Regional Board is requesting the federal period be **extended for a 1-year period, expiring on April 24, 2013.**
