Amendment to Chapter 3 of the Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region to modify the Implementation Provisions for Water Contact Recreation Bacteria Objectives

Adopted by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region on June 7, 2012.

Amendment:

Chapter 3. “Water Quality Objectives” of the Basin Plan, delete strikeout text and add underline text to the first and third paragraph under “Implementation Provisions for Water Contact Recreation Bacteria Objectives” as follows:

The geometric mean values shall be calculated based on a statistically sufficient number of samples (generally not less than 5 samples equally spaced over the calculation period).

If any of the single sample limits are exceeded, the Regional Board may require repeat sampling on a daily basis until the sample falls below the single sample limit in order to determine the persistence of the exceedance.

When repeat sampling is required because of an exceedance of any one single sample limit, values from all samples collected during that calculation period shall be used to calculate the geometric mean.
