A soil and groundwater investigation was conducted at the above-referenced site and a release of petroleum hydrocarbons was documented. Although some soil and groundwater contamination remain, this site meets the conditions for closure with similar attributes as required under the State Water Resources Control Board's "Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy." North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff proposes that no further work be required. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comment on this proposed decision.

Problem Description

An unauthorized discharge of petroleum hydrocarbons was discovered at the site that required additional soil and groundwater investigation to define the extent of contamination. Corrective action was subsequently implemented. Recent investigations determined the extent of contamination is limited and the residual levels of petroleum contamination are anticipated to naturally attenuate to water quality objectives in a reasonable amount of time, while not impacting human health or the environment.

Proposed Action

Case closure is proposed. Unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this site, Regional Water Board staff plans to proceed with the closure process upon conclusion of the comment period.
