The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment Tentative Order No. R9-2025-0001 *Amending Order No. R9-2022-0005 As Amended By Order No. R9-2024-0005, NPDES No. CA0107417 Waste Discharge Requirements for the South Orange County Wastewater Authority Discharge to the Pacific Ocean through the San Juan Creek Ocean Outfall* (Tentative Order). If adopted, the Tentative Order will update the address for the Chiquita Water Reclamation Plant; adds discharge prohibition, effluent limitations, and monitoring requirements for the proposed Ranch Water Filtration Plant; updates the discharger/ownership of 3A Water Reclamation Plant; and corrects some typographical errors.
