## Errata and Proposed Language Changes to Tentative Resolution No. R9-2007-0211

- 1. Page 9, Notification Condition 1(a)i is change to refer to Finding 11, and not to Finding 10.
- 2. Page 10, Notification Condition 3 has the following text added at the end of the paragraph.

If part or all of a discharge activity that is enrolled in RGP No. 63 is determined to occur in non-federal waters of the State prior to the completion of the activity (i.e. submittal of RGP No. 63 completion report), the discharger shall submit a Notice of Intent to the San Diego Water Board within 30 days of notification of jurisdictional changes by the USACE. The project applicant may request that the San Diego Water Board consider actions taken to satisfy the requirements of RGP No. 63 as sufficient to fulfill the conditions set forth in this waiver.

3. Page 10, Notification Condition 3 is revised as follows.

The discharger must send the San Diego Water Board a signed, completed Notice of Termination (Attachment No. 2) within 4510 working days of completing the discharge and restoration activities, and restoring the site to its original condition. Sites must be restored by the expiration date of this waiver.

4. The following footnote is added to page 1, Section I of the Notice of Intent.

Sufficient location information must be submitted to properly identify the project. In certain instances, some location information may be omitted until the Notice of Termination is completed. A single Notice of Intent may be submitted for a project involving several locations over a large geographic area and being conducted by a single project proponent.
