Vicente:

- 1) In reviewing the six permits linked below, I noticed that they do not contain an express prohibition against discharges that cause or contribution to violations of California water-quality standards. Did I miss this prohibition? If so, where is it located? If not, why is the prohibition not in these permits? The permits must contain this prohibition.
- 2) What is the legal basis for the claim in the fact sheet that the CTR does not apply to stormwater discharges? That proposition is false. The State Implementation Plan includes a footnote suggesting that it, the SIP itself, does not apply to stormwater, but there is no legal authority indicating that the CTR itself does not apply to stormwater. I'd like to know what legal authority the fact sheet's claim is based on.
