SUBJECT: TENTATIVE ORDER NO. R9-2008-0082; NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0109193; WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR GENENTECH, INC. DISCHARGE TO THE PACIFIC OCEAN THROUGH THE OCEANSIDE OCEAN OUTFALL

Enclosed is a copy of Tentative Order No. R9-2008-0082, NPDES Permit No. CA0109193, including a monitoring and reporting program and fact sheet which Regional Board staff intends to present to the Regional Board for adoption at their regularly scheduled meeting on September 10, 2008.

If adopted, tentative Order No. R9-2008-0082, NPDES Permit No. CA0109347, would update waste discharge requirements for the discharge of waste associated with water softening and purification processes and other non-biologics maintenance activities at the Genentech facility to the Pacific Ocean via the Oceanside Ocean Outfall. If adopted, Order No. R9-2008-0082 would supersede Order No. R9-2003-0140, except for enforcement purposes.

To ensure that the Regional Board has the opportunity to fully study and consider written material, comments should be received by the Regional Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 27, 2008. Per Regional Board direction, written material submitted to the Regional Board office after the submittal deadline date will not be provided to the Regional Board. Also, it is not likely that written material will be accepted by the Regional Board on the day of the meeting.
