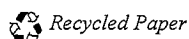

If adopted, Tentative Order No. R9-2009-0037, NPDES Permit No. CA0107492, would update waste discharge requirements for the discharge of treated wastewater effluent from the Padre Dam Municipal Water District Padre Dam Water Recycling Facility Discharge to Sycamore Creek, which is tributary to the San Diego River. If adopted, Order No. R9-2009-0037 would supersede Order No. R9-2003-0179, except for enforcement purposes.

Also, it is not likely that written material will be accepted by the Regional Board on the day of the meeting.
