
RE: Notice of Termination for BW-002

BAE Systems San Diego Ship Repair Inc. respectfully requests the termination of Outfall BW-002, ballast water from the floating drydock "Diligence", also known as "AFDL", as described in Order No. R9-2009-0080, NPDES No. CA0109151.

This drydock has been sold and will be removed from the facility, likely before June 30, 2010. Industrial activity on the drydock ceased in 2009. The last vessel undocked was on September 23, 2009. The drydock remains an active commercial vessel and is regulated under the federal Vessel General Permit (tracking No. VPABF9480). BAE Systems recognizes that once terminated no ship repair/industrial activity may be conducted on the vessel.
