Enclosed is a copy of Tentative Order No. R9-2011-0032, NPDES Permit No. CA0107336 (Tentative Order), including a monitoring and reporting program and fact sheet. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) intends to consider adoption of the enclosed subject Tentative Order at a San Diego Water Board meeting on May 11, 2011.

If adopted, the Tentative Order would update waste discharge requirements for the discharge of wastewater from exhibit pools and aquaria, intermittent flows during pool draining and cleaning operations, runoff from landscape irrigation, and facility wash down water. If adopted, the Tentative Order would supersede Order No. R9-2005-0091, except for enforcement purposes.
