NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD SAN DIEGO REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is proposing to issue a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for the discharge outlined in Table 1 below.

The Tentative Order will be issued on or about **December 17, 2013**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, if any, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the San Diego Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on January 16, 2014**. Written evidence, testimony or

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comments submitted after **5:00 p.m. on January 16, 2014**, will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the San Diego Water Board meeting and are expected to orally summarize their written comments. No new issues, not raised in timely submitted written testimony, evidence, or comments, will be permitted. Oral testimony will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
