NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is releasing, for public review and comment Tentative Order No. R9-2017-0179, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Baldwin and Sons, Village Two South Project San Diego County* (Tentative Order).

The San Diego Water Board is considering adoption of the Tentative Order in response to a Report of Waste Discharger (ROWD) application submitted by Baldwin and Sons (Discharger) for the discharge of fill material from the Village Two South Project (Project) to unnamed ephemeral drainages tributary to the Otay River near the intersection of Heritage Road and Santa Victoria in Chula Vista, CA.

The Tentative Order requires the Discharger to avoid and minimize adverse impacts to the aquatic resources of unnamed ephemeral drainages tributary to Otay River to ensure that the water quality standards for all waters of the State impacted by the Project are maintained after Project completion. The Tentative Order also authorizes unavoidable direct impacts to the unnamed ephemeral drainages attributed to the Project and requires the Discharger to implement compensatory mitigation sufficient to offset permitted Project impacts. Under the terms of the Tentative Order, the Applicant must also provide assurance that replacement of the full range of lost aquatic resource(s) and/or functions thorough compensatory mitigation will be provided in perpetuity.

Submission of Written Comments

Notice is hereby given that the San Diego Water Board will receive written comments on the aforementioned Tentative Order in accordance with this notice pursuant to Water Code section 13167.5.

The submission of written comments is the opportunity for interested persons to raise and comment on issues pertaining to the Tentative Order. All written comments pertaining to the Tentative Order to be considered by the San Diego Water Board must

be received no later than **5:00 p.m. on Monday December 11, 2017**. Written comments must be sent to the San Diego Water Board office attention to Lisa Honma or e-mailed to sandiego@waterboards.ca.gov. Please indicate in the subject line of all written comments "Comment - Tentative Order No. R9-2017-0179" indicating the Tentative Order being addressed. The early submission of written comments on the Tentative Order is encouraged.

Consistent with State Water Resources Control Board regulations that apply to this proceeding, written comments received after 5:00 p.m. on Monday December 11, 2017 will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

Public Hearing for Consideration of Tentative Order Adoption

A public hearing on this Tentative Order will be held during the San Diego Water Board meeting scheduled for **Wednesday, December 13, 2017**, at the **San Diego Regional Water Board Meeting Room, 2375 Northside Drive, San Diego California**. This item will be heard during a meeting that starts at 9:00 a.m. The meeting agenda, which will indicate any changes in the meeting location and may provide other specific information concerning this hearing, will be posted at least two weeks prior to the meeting date at http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sandiego/board_info/agendas/.
