NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is releasing Tentative Order No. R9-2018-0023, *Master Recycling Permit for the United States Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, Southern Regional Tertiary Treatment Plant, San Diego County* (Tentative Order) for public review and comment. The San Diego Water Board will consider adoption of the Tentative Order at its regularly scheduled meeting on **May 9, 2018**. The Tentative Order, if adopted, would prescribe requirements for the treatment and discharge of tertiary treated recycled water from the Southern Regional Tertiary Treatment Plant (SRTTP) owned by the U.S. Marine Corps at Camp Pendleton.

Notice is hereby given that the San Diego Water Board will receive written comments on the Tentative Order in accordance with this notice pursuant to Water Code section 13167.5. The submission of written comments is the opportunity for interested persons to raise and comment on issues pertaining to the Tentative Order.

Please review and provide any written comments on the Tentative Order **by 5:00 p.m. on April 23, 2018**. Comments should be submitted via email to sandiego@waterboards.ca.gov in text searchable Portable Document Format (PDF) or Microsoft Word format. Written comments can also be submitted via regular mail to the San Diego Water Board office at 2375 Northside Drive, San Diego, CA 92108. Please indicate in the subject line of the email or comment letter "Comment – Tentative Order No. R9-2018-0023, Attn: Alex Cali."

The early submission of written comments on the Tentative Order is encouraged. Written comments received by **5:00 p.m. on April 23, 2018**, will be provided to the San Diego Water Board members for their review in advance of the public hearing to consider adoption of the Tentative Order. The San Diego Water Board will prepare written responses to significant comments that are timely received. Consistent with State Water Resources Control Board regulations that apply to this proceeding, written comments received after **5:00 p.m. on April 23, 2018**, will not be accepted, and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

Public Hearing for Consideration of Tentative Order

A public hearing on the Tentative Order will be held during the San Diego Water Board meeting on **May 9, 2018**. The meeting will begin promptly at **9:00 AM** and will be held at the Council Chambers at the City of Mission Viejo, 200 Civic Center, Mission Viejo, California, 92691.
