NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is releasing Tentative Order No. R9-2019-0013, *An Order Rescinding Orders Nos. 93-14, 94-14 and R9-2009-0105* (Tentative Order) for public review and comment. The San Diego Water Board will consider adoption of the Tentative Order at its regularly scheduled meeting on **Wednesday, April 10, 2019**. The Tentative Order, if adopted, will rescind:

- Order No. 93-14, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Warner Springs Mobile Estates, San Diego County*;
- Order No. 94-14, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Thousand Trails, Inc. Oakzanita Springs Park San Diego County*; and
- Order No. R9-2009-0105, *Waste Discharge Requirements for The California Department of Transportation, District 11, Buckman Springs Safety Roadside Rest Area, San Diego County*

The Tentative Order, if adopted, will coincide with enrollment in State Water Resources Control Board Order WQ 2014-0153-DWQ, *General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems*,¹ for the discharges from the onsite wastewater treatment systems (OWTS) located at each of the above facilities.

The submission of written comments provides an opportunity for interested persons to raise and comment on issues pertaining to the Tentative Order.

Please review and provide written comments on the Tentative Order by **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 6, 2019**. Comments should be submitted via email to sandiego@waterboards.ca.gov in text searchable Portable Document Format (PDF) or Microsoft Word format. Written comments can also be submitted via regular mail to the San Diego Water Board office at 2375 Northside Drive, Suite 100, San Diego, California 92108-2700. Please indicate in the subject line of the email or comment letter "Comment – Tentative Order No. R9-2019-0013, Attn: Brandon Bushnell."

The early submission of written comments on the Tentative Order is encouraged. Written comments received by **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 6, 2019**, will be provided to the San Diego Water Board members for their review in advance of the public hearing to consider adoption of the Tentative Order. The San Diego Water Board will prepare written responses to significant comments that are timely received. Consistent with State Water Resources Control Board regulations that apply to this proceeding, written comments received after **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 6, 2019**, will not be accepted, and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

Public Hearing for Consideration of the Tentative Order

A public hearing on the Tentative Order will be held during the San Diego Water Board meeting on **Wednesday, April 10, 2019**. The meeting will begin promptly at **9:00 a.m.** and will be held in the City of Mission Viejo, Council Chambers, 200 Civic Center Drive, Mission Viejo, California 92691.
