The San Diego Water Board will consider adoption of the Tentative Order at its regularly scheduled meeting on **October 9, 2019.** The Tentative Order, if adopted, will rescind Order No. 83-09, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Julian Sanitation District, County of San Diego* and Addendum No. 1 to Order No. 83-09, *An Addendum Modifying the Requirements for Julian sanitation District, San Diego County.*

Notice is hereby given that the San Diego Water Board will accept written comments on the Tentative Order in accordance with this notice and pursuant to California Water Code section 13167.5.

The written comment period provides an opportunity for interested persons to comment on the Tentative Order. All written comments regarding the Tentative Order must be received no later than **5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 16, 2019**, to be considered by the San Diego Water Board. Written comments sent by mail must be addressed to California Regional Water Quality Control Board – San Diego Region, 2375 Northside Drive, Suite 100, San Diego, California 92108-2700, and ATTN: Ms. Sherrie Komeylyan. Comments can also be submitted by e-mail to sandiego@waterboards.ca.gov. The subject line of all written comments must include "Comment – Tentative Order No. R9-2019-0164."

The early submission of written comments on the Tentative Order is encouraged. Written comments received by **5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 16, 2019**, will be provided to the San Diego Water Board members for their review in advance of the public hearing to consider adoption of the Tentative Order. The San Diego Water Board will prepare written responses to significant comments that are timely received. Consistent with State Water Resources Control Board regulations that apply to this proceeding, written comments received after **5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 16, 2019**, will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

A public hearing on this Tentative Order will be held during the San Diego Water Board meeting on October 9, 2019, beginning promptly at 9:00a.m. The meeting will be held in the San Diego Water Board Meeting Room, located at 2375 Northside Drive, Suite 100, San Diego, California, 92108.
