**Waste Discharge Requirements: Order No. 93-09  
Facility: Heise Park Campground**

**YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT:**

The County of San Diego (County) violated Order No. 93-09, Waste Discharge Requirements for Heise Park Campground, San Diego County. These violations subject the County to possible further enforcement action by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board), including administrative enforcement orders requiring the County to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation;<sup>2</sup> referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The San Diego Water Board identified two violations of Order No. 93-09 in the January–June and July–December 2009 semi-annual and 2009 annual monitoring reports submitted by the County. The following summarizes the two violations:

**Summary of Violationss**

There were two violations of the daily maximum discharge specification for chloride, established at 90 milligrams per liter (mg/L). One violation occurred on January 28, 2009 and the other on July 20, 2009 with reported values of 103 and 102 mg/L, respectively.

**SUBJECT: NOTICE OF VIOLATION NO. R9-2010-0076  
HEISE PARK CAMPGROUND**

Enclosed is Notice of Violation (NOV) No. R9-2010-0076 for the discharge of inadequately treated wastewater at the Heise Park Campground in violation of Order No. 93-09. The basis for this NOV was the monitoring data contained in the January–June and July–December 2009 semi-annual and 2009 annual monitoring reports submitted by the County of San Diego (County) in accordance with Order No. 93-09.

Please take steps to implement the follow-up actions necessary to ensure that the violations noted do not occur in the future. These violations subject the County to possible further enforcement action by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board), including administrative enforcement orders requiring the County to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation;<sup>1</sup> referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The County has been in violation of the chloride discharge specification since at least 2002. The County has the following options to remediate the violations addressed in this NOV:

1. Eliminate the sources of chloride from the influent.
2. Investigate technology to remove chloride from the effluent.
3. Provide justification that relaxation of the discharge specification will not cause or contribute to exceedance of groundwater water quality objectives. The



justification must take into account the assimilative capacity of the basin, recharge rates to the basin, and chloride loading to the basin.

The next monitoring report required to be submitted is the January to June 2010 semi-annual monitoring report due on July 30, 2010.
