SUBJECT: MONITORING REPORT REVIEW FOR S&S FARM SWINE FACILITY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the November 1, 2008–October 31, 2009 annual monitoring report which was submitted in accordance with the Monitoring and Reporting Program MRP of Order No. R9-2009-0077.

The following violations have been identified in the submitted report:

1. MRP Section A.2.d requires you to monitor the groundwater elevation. This information was not included in the annual report.
2. In the monitoring report form, the groundwater monitoring results require you to report the name of the laboratory and individual who performed analyses, the date analyses were performed, and the analytical techniques used. This information was not completed in the table and there were no lab sheets submitted with the report.

Please be aware these violations subject you to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board, including administrative enforcement orders requiring the you to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation;¹ referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The next monitoring report required to be submitted is the November 1, 2009–October 31, 2010 semiannual monitoring report, which is due by December 1, 2010.
