**SUBJECT: REVIEW OF MONITORING REPORTS FOR KKOTTONGNAE RETREAT
CAMP**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) has reviewed the July-December 2010, January-June 2011, and July-December 2011 semiannual, along with the 2010 and 2011 annual monitoring reports submitted by Kkottongnae Inc. in accordance with Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 93-43.

The following violation of Section B.1 (Discharge Specifications) of Order No. 93-43 was identified in the submitted reports:

1. The daily maximum discharge specification for nitrate established at 10 milligrams per liter (mg/L), was exceeded on December 14, 2011 with a reported value of 16 mg/L.

The following violation of Section D.4 (Reporting Requirements) of Order No. 93-43 was identified in the submitted report:

2. Information regarding visitor-use-days and water consumption was not included in the addressed monitoring reports. Section F (Visitor Use Days and Water Consumption) of Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 93-43 requires you to submit monthly logs of visitor-use days and water consumption semiannually.



Please be aware these violations subject you to possible further enforcement action by the San Diego Water Board, including administrative enforcement orders requiring the you to cease and desist from violations, or to clean up waste and abate existing or threatened conditions of pollution or nuisance; administrative assessment of civil liability in amounts of up to \$5,000 per day per violation;¹ referral to the State Attorney General for injunctive relief; and referral to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution.

The next monitoring report required to be submitted is the January-June 2012 semiannual monitoring report, which is due by July 30, 2012.
