**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC TO ATTEND FOCUSED MEETING 2
for**

**The Reissuance of the Regional Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems Permit,
Order R9-2013-0001, for the San Diego Region**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is hosting a series of focused meetings in 2023 for the permit reissuance of the Regional Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) Permit, Order No. R9-2013-0001, as amended¹ by Order Nos. R9-2015-0001 and R9-2015-0100 (Regional MS4 Permit). The San Diego Water Board regulates discharges from Phase I MS4s in the San Diego Region under the Regional MS4 Permit. The Regional MS4 Permit covers 39 municipal, county government, and special district entities (referred to jointly as Copermittees) located in San Diego County, southern Orange County, and southwestern Riverside County who own and operate large MS4s which discharge stormwater runoff and non-stormwater runoff to surface waters throughout the San Diego Region. The purpose of the focused meetings is for the San Diego Water Board to discuss proposed changes to the Regional MS4 Permit and hear preliminary input from the Copermittees and interested persons.

Directions and Parking

Directions from Downtown San Diego:

Via Public Transportation: Green Line light rail towards Santee to Fenton Parkway Station. Walk to 2375 Northside Drive (about 9 minutes). Head northwest on Fenton Parkway to Northside Drive. Right on Northside Drive.

Driving from I-15 north – take the Friars Road West exit (toward Snapdragon Stadium) – follow signs to stay on Friars Road. Turn left onto Northside Drive. Turn left at first signal (Fenton Marketplace Drwy). Our building is located at the end of the court.

Directions from the North:

Via Public Transportation: Pacific Surfliner Train 572 towards San Diego Santa Fe Depot. Walk

to San Diego Old Town Transit Center (about 1 minute). Green Line light rail towards Santee to Fenton Parkway Station. Walk to 2375 Northside Drive (about 9 minutes). Head northwest on Fenton Parkway to Northside Drive. Right on Northside Drive.

Driving from I-15 south – take the Friars Road West exit – follow signs to stay on Friars Road. Turn left onto Northside Drive. Turn left at first signal (Fenton Marketplace Drwy). Our building is located at the end of the court.

Parking:

Parking will be available in **one** location for the meeting. The 2-hour visitor spaces will be available for 3-hour parking the day of the meeting. The visitor spaces are located directly to the east of the San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board building. This parking location is located at the end of the court and outside of the parking structure. Spaces may be limited on the day of the meeting. The parking structure is not available. The only parking available on site is the visitor parking.
