SUBJECT: **SAUSALITO-MARIN CITY SANITARY DISTRICT, SAUSALITO, MARIN COUNTY** - Hearing to Consider Mandatory Minimum Penalty for Violations of NPDES Permit Resulting in the Discharge of Partially Treated Wastewater to Waters of the State

CHRONOLOGY: September 2000: Mandatory Minimum Penalty
May 2001: Mandatory Minimum Penalty

DISCUSSION: Between February 2001 and March 2002, the Sausalito-Marín City Sanitary District had seven violations of its effluent limitations. These violations are: one total suspended solids violation, two chlorine residual violations, and four total coliform violations. Four of these violations are subject to mandatory minimum penalties, for a total of \$12,000.

The District has waived its right to a hearing, and has proposed two supplemental environmental projects (SEP). One SEP for \$6,000 will be used at the Sausalito Bay Model for ongoing public education programs on human impacts on aquatic environments. The other SEP is being developed. The attached complaint for \$12,000 will be suspended to fund the proposed SEPs.
