SUBJECT: **Delta Diablo Sanitation District, Wastewater Treatment Plant, Antioch, Contra Costa County** – Amendment of NPDES Permit

CHRONOLOGY: December 2003 - NPDES Permit Reissued

DISCUSSION: Delta Diablo Sanitation District (Delta Diablo) owns and operates a secondary treatment plant in Antioch that serves the cities of Antioch, Pittsburg, and Bay Point. Delta Diablo discharges treated effluent through a diffuser to New York Slough at the western end of the Delta, which is a municipal drinking water supply source. Due to an oversight by our contractor, Delta Diablo's 2003 Permit did not apply the appropriate objectives for a number of organic toxic pollutants for protection of the drinking water beneficial use. This amendment corrects the oversight. The results are lower limits for two pollutants, and new limits for three pollutants not in the 2003 Permit. Available data show that Delta Diablo will be able to comply with these changes.

Delta Diablo and the Contra Costa Water District submitted comments on the Tentative Order (T.O.). Delta Diablo is in general agreement with the T.O. and is not contesting this amendment. The Response to Comments (Appendix D) provides details on all issues raised.
