Richmond Refinery

DISCUSSION: The attached Tentative Order serves as Site Cleanup Requirements and
Clean Water Act Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the Castro
Cove Sediment Remediation Project and is complimentary to Agenda Item
6, a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the same project.

The Tentative Order requires remediation of sediment contamination in a
portion of Castro Cove that poses unacceptable risk to ecological
receptors. A general project description can be found in the Staff
Summary Report for Item 6.
