**PROPOSED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR
THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S INTERSTATE 80 (I-80)
WESTBOUND CORDELIA COMMERCIAL VEHICLE ENFORCEMENT FACILITY PROJECT**

NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN THAT the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) will accept written comments on the Tentative Order for issuing Water Quality Certification and Waste Discharge Requirements for the Interstate 80 (I-80) Westbound Cordelia Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Facility Project in unincorporated Solano County.

The Tentative Order would authorize the placement of fill in waters of the State for the construction of a Class B Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Facility (Facility) and two new off-ramps to the Facility on I-80 westbound by the California Department of Transportation.
