The Santa Ana Water Board will consider the adoption of Waste Discharge Requirements for the Silverado Fire Damaged Restoration Project. The Project will upgrade existing roadway facilities to current standards with increased resiliency to extreme weather. The Project will temporarily impact 0.225 acres of waters of the State as a result of drainage pipe and safety device replacement and improvement within the original footprints.

Item *7. Waste Discharge Requirements for City of Irvine, Irvine Gateway Village, Irvine, Orange County

The Santa Ana Water Board will consider the adoption of Waste Discharge Requirements for the Irvine Gateway Village Project. The Project will develop a new residential community, associated infrastructure, and recreational facilities within 105 acres. The Project will result in 0.32 acres of permanent impacts to ephemeral streambed waters of the State due to grading and undergrounding of existing drainage features.

Pursuant to Water Code sections 13376 and 13385, the Board will consider adoption of Order No. R8-2025-0066 Assessing Administrative Civil Liability in the matter of Wicked Creations, Inc. The hearing on this matter is closed, and no further evidence will be admitted. Public comments on the proposed order will be limited to three (3) minutes. The Santa Ana Water Board is authorized to meet in closed session to further deliberate on the decision. (Action item)
