EVALUATION OF CNI MANUFACTURING EVR PHASE I SYSTEM WITH EMCO WHEATON COMPONENTS (VR 104-C)

As you know, Assembly Bill 2955 (Statutes 2004, Chapter 649) added section 25290.1.2(a) to Chapter 6.7 of the Health and Safety Code (H&SC). This section requires the Air Resources Board (ARB) and State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) to certify, to the best of their knowledge and using existing resources, that equipment meeting the ARB's Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) requirements also meets underground storage tank (UST) statutory requirements.

On September 27, 2006, we received an information packet from you detailing a proposed modification to the current CNI Manufacturing EVR Phase I System. The proposed modification would allow Emco Wheaton overfill prevention valves and swivel adaptors to be used with the CNI Manufacturing EVR Phase I system. The proposed modifications were reviewed by a California Registered Professional Engineer, as indicated in the enclosed signed statement. Based on this signed statement and the supporting information that you provided, we have found no evidence that the CNI Manufacturing EVR Phase I System conflicts with H&SC Chapter 6.7.

Pursuant to H&SC section 25290.1.2(a) the State Water Board certifies that, to the best of its knowledge, the CNI Manufacturing EVR Phase I System (available in direct bury and secondarily contained configurations) meets the requirements of H&SC Chapter 6.7. This determination assumes the CNI Manufacturing EVR Phase I System is installed in accordance with applicable ARB Executive Orders and manufacturer's instructions.
