EVALUATION OF EMCO WHEATON RETAIL EVR PHASE I SYSTEM

As you know, Assembly Bill 2955 (Statutese!004, Chapter 649) added section 25290.1.2(a) to Chapter 6.7 of the Health and Safety Code(H&SC). This section requires the Air Resources Board (ARB) and State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) to certify, to the best of their knowledge and using existing resources, that equipment meeting the ARB's Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) requirements also meets underground storage tank (UST) statutory requirements.

On March 15, 2006 we received on your behalf the enclosed signed statement by a California Registered Professional Engineer. Based on this statement and the information that Emco Wheaton provided to us, we have found no evidence that the Emco Wheaton Retail EVR Phase I System conflicts with H&SC Chapter 6.7. However, the direct burial configuration of this system does not provide secondary containment for the tank fill riser as required for certain UST systems pursuant to Chapter 6.7 of the Health and Safety Code and implementing regulations. Accordingly, the direct burial configuration can only be used on UST systems where secondary containment of the fill riser is not required.

Pursuant to H&SC section 25290.1.2(a) the State Water Board certifies that, to the best of its knowledge, the Emco Wheaton Retail EVR Phase I System (available in direct bury and multi-port configurations) meets the requirements of H&SC Chapter 6.7. This determination assumes the Emco Wheaton Retail EVR Phase I System is installed in accordance with applicable ARB Executive Orders and in accordance with manufacturer's instructions, as required by State Water Board regulations.
