NOTICE OF VACATED PUBLIC HEARING AND PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE

The State Water Resources Control Board
Administrative Hearings Office
was scheduled to hold a Pre-Hearing Conference, and Public Hearing
on the petitions for change filed by

Santa Clara Valley Water District

for Licenses 6943 (A005653), 11791 (A005654), 2205 (A007141), 2206 (A007142), 2207 (A007143), 2208 (A008098), 2209 (A008099), 6944 (A008387), 2837 (A009455), and 5729 (A0011751).

The Pre-Hearing Conference scheduled on February 5, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.,

The Public Hearing scheduled on March 9, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.,

and to continue on March 10, 12, 16, 17, 19, 23, 24, 26, 30, and April 2 and 6, at 9:00 a.m.

are hereby vacated

On November 18, 2025, the parties to this hearing informed the Administrative Hearings Office (AHO) that they have agreed in principle to: (a) an agreement to resolve and withdraw all protests to Santa Clara Valley Water District's (Valley Water) petitions for change; (b) proposed water right conditions; and (c) the substance of a revised Fish Habitat Restoration Plan to be incorporated into such water right conditions. The parties have committed to submitting a comprehensive written agreement to the State Water Resources Control Board by January 16, 2026. To accommodate their efforts to reduce their agreement in principle to writing, the parties have jointly requested a continuance of all pre-hearing and hearing dates.

Based on the representations in the parties' joint request for a continuance, all hearing dates and associated pre-hearing deadlines set forth in the Second Amended Notice of Public Hearing and Pre-Hearing Conference (Aug. 4, 2025) are hereby vacated.

The parties are directed to submit a joint status conference statement that contains the following information no later than January 16, 2026, at 11:59 p.m.:

- 1. An executed agreement to resolve and withdraw protests;
- 2. Proposed water right conditions for License Nos. 6943, 11791, 2205, 2206, 2207, 2208, 2209, 6944, and 5729;
- A revised Fish Habitat Restoration Plan; and
- 4. The parties' proposed procedure by which the State Water Resources Control Board may act on the pending petitions for change in accordance with their comprehensive written agreement.

The AHO will review the parties' joint status conference statement and, if necessary, may schedule a status conference to consider the procedural pathway by which the State Water Board may act on Valley Water's change petitions in accordance with the parties' comprehensive agreement.
