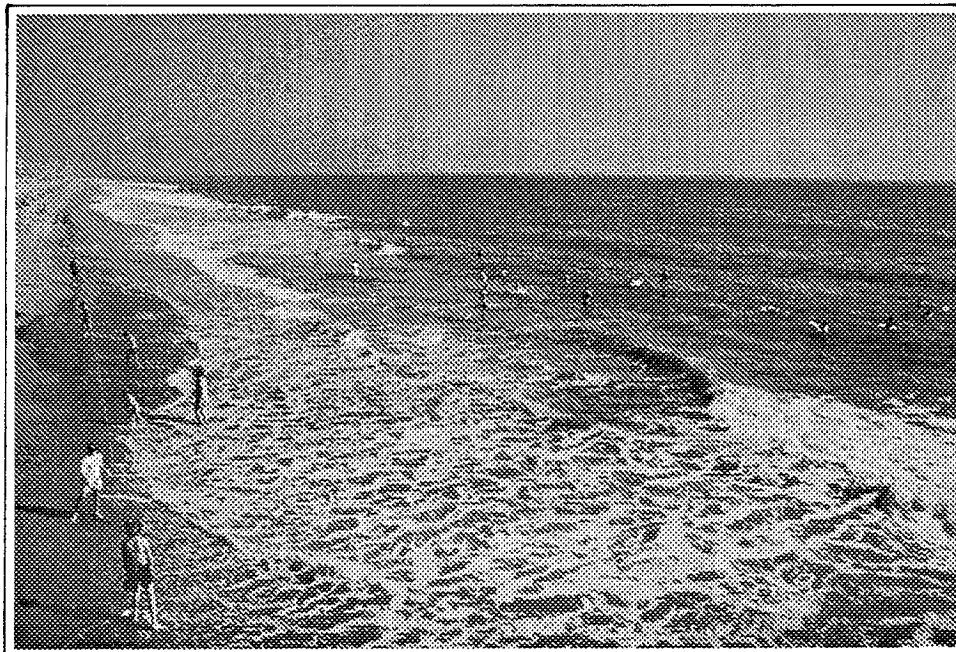

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Chapter 961, Statutes of 1992 (SB 1965, Hart) requires the Director of Environmental Health of each coastal county to report to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) annually by March 30 the number of beach closures due to threats to public health on public beaches within their jurisdiction for the preceding calendar year. The SWRCB is then required to submit this information to the Legislature by the following September 30. This is the first report prepared by the SWRCB to satisfy this legislative mandate.

Table 1 lists the number of beach closures for 1993 for each coastal county, organized geographically from north to south. Figure 1 presents the same information on a map of California. Following the summary table and map are the submittals from each county to SWRCB in a standard format.

There were no reported beach closures in counties north of San Francisco Bay. There were a total of 92 reported beach closures in seven of the nine counties south of San Francisco Bay. The majority of the closures were due to the release of inadequately treated sewage. A few closures were the result of oil spills, vessel spills, and, in one case, contamination due to a power failure. The majority of the closures (62 of the 92 beach closures) occurred in San Diego County. San Diego County reported extensive damage to sewage pump stations and treatment facilities as a result of the heavy rainfall occurring in 1993.

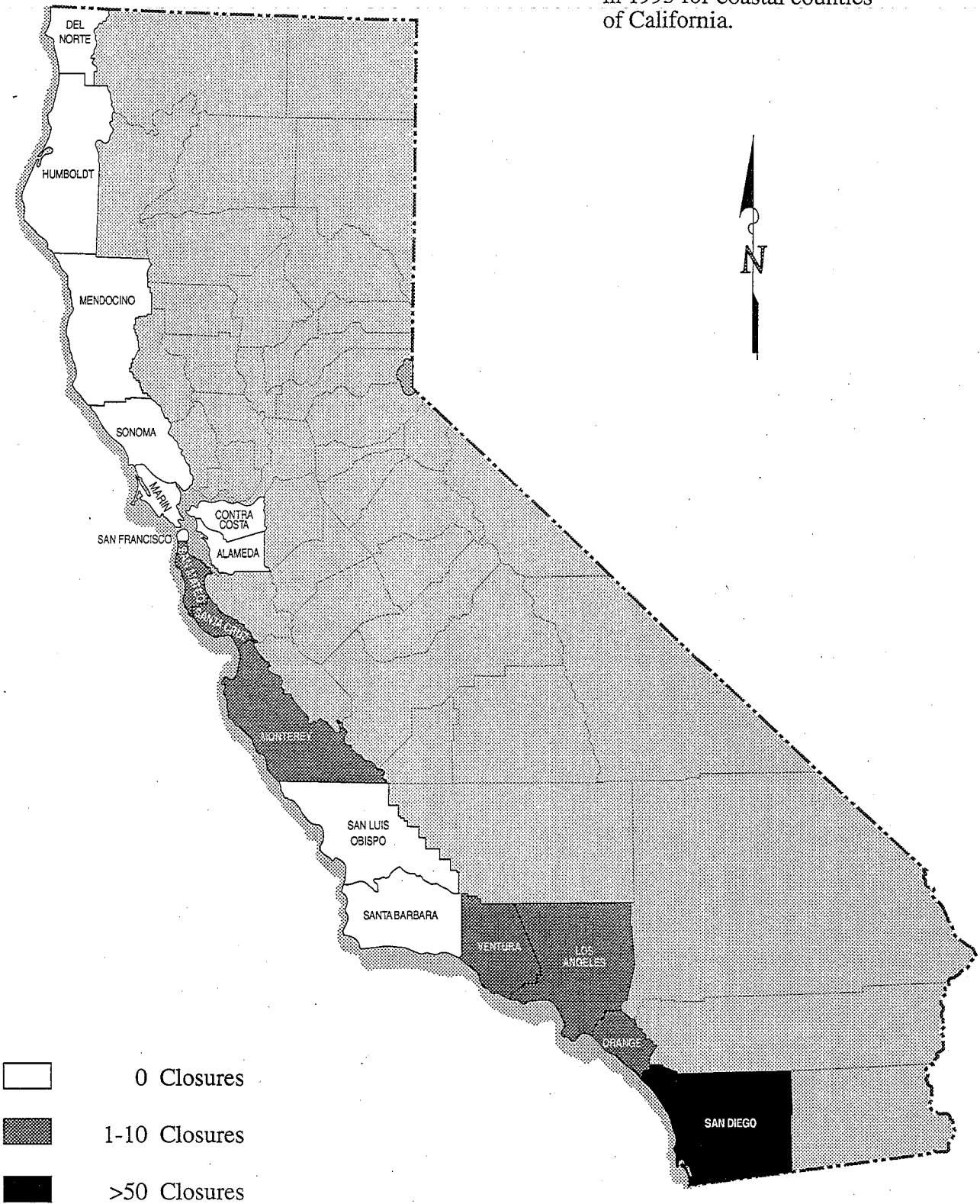
