Corona for all nurposes 20 Defendants. 21 22 Plaintiff the People of The State of California ex rel. the State Water Resources Control 23 Board (State Water Board) alleges on information and belief as follows: 24 Plaintiff brings this action against Defendants Franzen-Hill Corporation, Mr. David 25 1. L. Martin, Mr. Exequiel Sinco, and Does 1 through 10 to obtain civil penalties and injunctive 26 relief pursuant to Health and Safety Code sections 25284.4 and 25299.01. 27 28

- 2. The State Water Board is a public agency of the State of California. The State Water Board's jurisdiction includes the regulation and protection of the waters of the State of California, including its rivers, creeks, and groundwater.
- 3. The Franzen-Hill Corporation is a California corporation, located at 1100 North J Street, Tulare, California. It designs, builds, and maintains fueling facilities, including underground storage tanks for petroleum products.
- 4. Mr. David L. Martin is an individual. He is and was at all relevant times herein an employee of the Franzen-Hill Corporation.
- 5. Mr. Exequiel Sinco is an individual. He is and was at all relevant times herein an employee of the Franzen-Hill Corporation.
- 6. Plaintiff is not aware of the true names and capacities of the defendants sued as Does 1 through 10, inclusive, and therefore sues these defendants by such fictitious names, pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 474. Each of these fictitiously named defendants is responsible in some manner for the activities alleged in this complaint. Plaintiffs will amend this complaint to add the true names of the fictitiously named defendants once they are discovered.
- 7. Hereinafter, Franzen-Hill Corporation, David L. Martin, Exequiel Sinco, and Does 1 through 10 are collectively referred to as the Defendants.
- 8. At all relevant times, each Defendant committed the acts, caused or directed others to commit the acts, ratified the acts, or permitted others to commit the acts alleged in this complaint. Additionally, some or all of the Defendants acted as the agent of the other Defendants, and all of the Defendants acted within the scope of their agency if acting as an agent of another.
- 9. At all relevant times, each Defendant knew or realized that the other Defendants were engaging in or planned to engage in the violations of law alleged in this Complaint. Knowing or realizing that other Defendants were engaging in or planning to engage in unlawful conduct, each Defendant nevertheless facilitated the commission of those unlawful acts. Each Defendant intended to and did encourage, facilitate, or assist in the commission of the unlawful acts, and thereby aided and abetted the other Defendants in the unlawful conduct.

### VENUE

10. This action is venued in Fresno County because Franzen-Hill Corporation has its principal place of business in Tulare County, and the nearest Attorney General's Office is in Fresno County, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25299.03.

# **BACKGROUND**

- 11. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25284.4, subdivision (a), all tank integrity tests shall be performed only by, or under the direct and personal supervision of, a tank tester with a currently valid tank testing license. Furthermore, no person shall engage in the business of tank integrity testing, or act in the capacity of a tank tester, within California without first obtaining a tank testing license from the State Water Board. Any person who violates section 25284.4, subdivision (a), may be subject to civil penalties of up to \$2,500 per day for each violation, pursuant to section 25284.4, subdivision (g).
- 12. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25299.01, when any person has violated Chapter 6.7 of Division 20 of the Health and Safety Code, including section 25284.4, the Superior Court may issue any order enjoining these acts or practices, or for an order directing compliance.

# FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION: PERFORMING TANK INTEGRITY TESTS WITHOUT A CURRENTLY VALID TANK TESTING LICENSE FROM THE STATE WATER BOARD (Against All Defendants)

- 13. Plaintiff incorporates by this reference each and all of the allegations contained in paragraphs 1 through 12 of this complaint, as though fully set forth herein.
- 14. Between 2005 and the present, Defendants performed tank integrity tests, engaged in the business of tank integrity testing, and acted in the capacity of a tank tester at least thirty times in California.
- 15. Between 2005 and the present, Franzen-Hill Corporation's agents or employees performed these thirty or more tank integrity tests without having a currently valid tank testing license from the State Water Board and without being under the direct and personal supervision of someone having such a license.

- 16. Franzen-Hill Corporation is liable for a civil penalty of up to \$2,500 per day for each unlawful tank integrity test performed by any of its employees or agents.
- 17. David L. Martin is liable for a civil penalty of up to \$2,500 per day for each unlawful tank integrity test that he performed.
- 18. Exequiel Sinco is liable for a civil penalty of up to \$2,500 per day for each unlawful tank integrity test that he performed.

## PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, plaintiff seeks judgment against each and all of the defendants as follows:

- 1. For civil penalties in an amount to be determined at the time of trial, but in a total amount of no less than \$75,000.00.
- 2. For a permanent injunction to enjoin Defendants and Franzen-Hill Corporation's officers, directors, principals, agents, representatives, employees, successors, and assignees, and all persons, corporations and other entities acting by, through, under or on behalf of any one or more of the Defendants, or acting in concert or participation with any one or more of the Defendants, which enjoins Defendants as follows:
  - (a) The Franzen-Hill Corporation shall not engage in the business of tank integrity testing or allow any employee to act in the capacity of a tank tester unless those tests are performed by (or under the direct and personal supervision of) testers with currently valid tank testing licenses from the State Water Board, in accordance with Health and Safety Code section 25284.4, subdivision (a).
  - (b) Mr. Martin shall not engage in the business of tank integrity testing or act in the capacity of a tank tester unless he has a currently valid tank testing license from the State Water Board, in accordance with Health and Safety Code section 25284.4, subdivision (a).
  - (c) Mr. Sinco shall not engage in the business of tank integrity testing or act in the capacity of a tank tester unless he has a currently valid tank testing license from the State Water Board, in accordance with Health and Safety Code section 25284.4, subdivision (a).
  - 3. For Plaintiff's costs of suit; and

1	4. For such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
