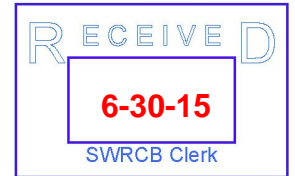

For an Area-Specific Groundwater Monitoring Plan, I have the following request:

Item 2.1.2.9. Please delete the requirement to have API numbers for the wells to be stimulated. The reason for the request is we plan to have groundwater monitoring wells in the proper location and sampled within the correct timeframe so that the entire field will be under surveillance. To impose this API restriction adds time which costs both oil companies and the state lost revenue. The environment and groundwater will not be jeopardized under this request.
