

These 34 areas along the coast, were given special protection status decades ago to safeguard the unique and sensitive biological species and communities found in these areas.

Over twenty years ago, the State Water Board adopted a pollution discharge prohibition to protect these resources, which by definition thrive only in natural water quality. Unfortunately, the clear prohibition on pollution into these biologically important areas has been largely ignored over the years, and there are now more than habitats for sensitive species.

I am in full support of strong actions to protect these areas from pollution, including robust measures to protect and restore ASBSs
