We support the draft General Industrial Stormwater Permit as proposed because it provides a rational, cost-effective approach for businesses like TIMEC to protect water supplies.

We understand, however, that some have asked for amendments requiring numeric limits for stormwater discharges. Such an approach violates state and federal guidelines for stormwater management and would be ineffective because of the nature of stormwater.
