We would like to make a suggested addition to Section IX. Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), A. SWPPP Preparation, Implementation and Oversight, 1. Qualified Developer on behalf of the Certified Professional Soil Scientists/Classifiers (CPSS/C) of the Soil Science Society of America (SSSA).

Soil is a primary feature that must be considered and evaluated when developing an appropriate SWPPP. Without the soil components, the SWPPP is destined for failure. Our suggested recommendation is to list CPSS/C as one of the required certifications that must be held by a qualified SWPPP developer.

Suggested language:

3. A Certified Professional Soil Scientist/Classifier as certified by the Soil Science Society of America.

Each CPSS/C must pass two comprehensive exams, have at least 5 years of experience with a minimum of a Bachelor of Science degree in soil science. They must earn 40 hours of continuing education in soil science related topics every two-years to maintain their certification and they signed the code of ethics.
