

Dear Ms. Townsand:

Thank you so very much for your November 3, 2010, Wednesday, telephone message. Please note that I have checked the Board's Website's Documents for Public Comment section a number of times yesterday evening, and this morning, and I am still encountering the same problems with the public NOTICE addresses and e-mails for the aforementioned subject.

Ms. Townsend, taking into consideration the possibility that the problem is with our home business computer and not the State Water Board's, I went shead and reviewed the public notices listed on the Board's Documents for Public Comment section with the deadlines of 11/2/10 to 12/6/10. What I found is that the problem is with the Agency's Webmaster because the problem of inaccessibility with the addresses and e-mails for the MS4s NOTICE also occurs with the NOTICE for the Once Through Cooling. These Notices also state "(i) You are viewing the document in PDF/A mode".

Ms. Townsend, please note that when the addresses in the Notices for the Aquatic Animal Invasive Species Control NPDES Permit, and the Draft Spray Applications NPDES Permit are clicked what appears is "Error: 404 - The page you requested could not be found. . "

Ms. Townsend, please note that I did not encounter any accessibility problems with all of the other posted public Notices from 11/2/10 to 12/6/10.

Ms. Townsend, I was able to access the MS4s 50 page document by entering the address listed on the posted public NOTICE. The following are my comments on the "Effectiveness Assessment Document" for the Board's consideration for now.

- #2 Include a numbered "Table of Contents" page(s) for the 50-page document.
- #3 Pages 27, 28, 34, 35, 36, and 37 are blank. Page 28 does not include a line number.
- #4 Page 38, include "Region" and the number for "San Diego County MS4 Permit(beginning at page 58/119)".
- #5 Page 43, include "Region" and the number for "City of Stockton/San Joaquin County beginning at page 60/142".

ERRORS

- 1. Page 10, "A. Implementation Assessment (Outcome Level 1)", indentation between "A." and "Implementation".
- 2. Page 11, bullet square(point), top of page(first set of), indentation. Figure 2 is blank.
- 3. Page 15, "2. Outcomes, Measures and Methods", underline the same as "1. Overview" for consistency.
- 4. Page 16, "1. Overview", underline the same as "1. Overview" for consistency.
- 5. Page 19, "1. Overview", underline the same as "1. Overview" for consistency.
- 6. Page 21, "1. General Considerations", underline the same as "1. Overview" for consistency. "1. General Considerations" indentation.
- 7. Page 22, line number 791, "(see Table 3 below as an example)", Table 3 is not in bold print. "2. Considerations for MS4 Discharge Monitoring", underline the same as "1. Overview" for consistency. Table 3, no dash between "3" and "Example".
- 8. Page 23, "3. Considerations for Receiving Water Assessment", underline the same as "1. Overview" for consistency. "3. Considerations for Receiving Water Assessment" indentation.

- 9. Page 24, "3. Outcomes, Measures and Methods", underline the same as "1. Overview" for consistency. This number is number "2."! "a." through "c." (Objective 1), and "a." through "b." (Objective 2), indentations.
- 10. Page 26, Table 4, type of dash between "4" and "Key".
- 11.Page 42, "Orange County Permit(Region 8) beginning at Page 90/93", "(" and ")" are missing.
- 12. Page 43, "City of Stockton/San Joaquin County beginning on page 60/142", "(" and ")" are missing.

QUESTIONS

- 1. Why were the textual lines numbered? (Pages 1 50)
- 2. Why were the points in bold given "1)" through "5)" numbers instead of labeling them as "a." through "e."? (Page 20)
- 3. Why were the three Objectives not formatted with bullet points for consistency? (Page 24)
