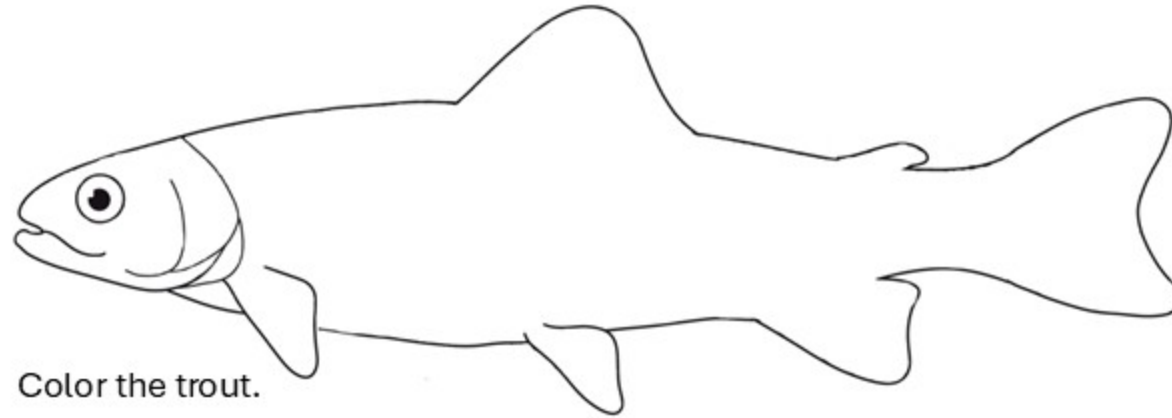
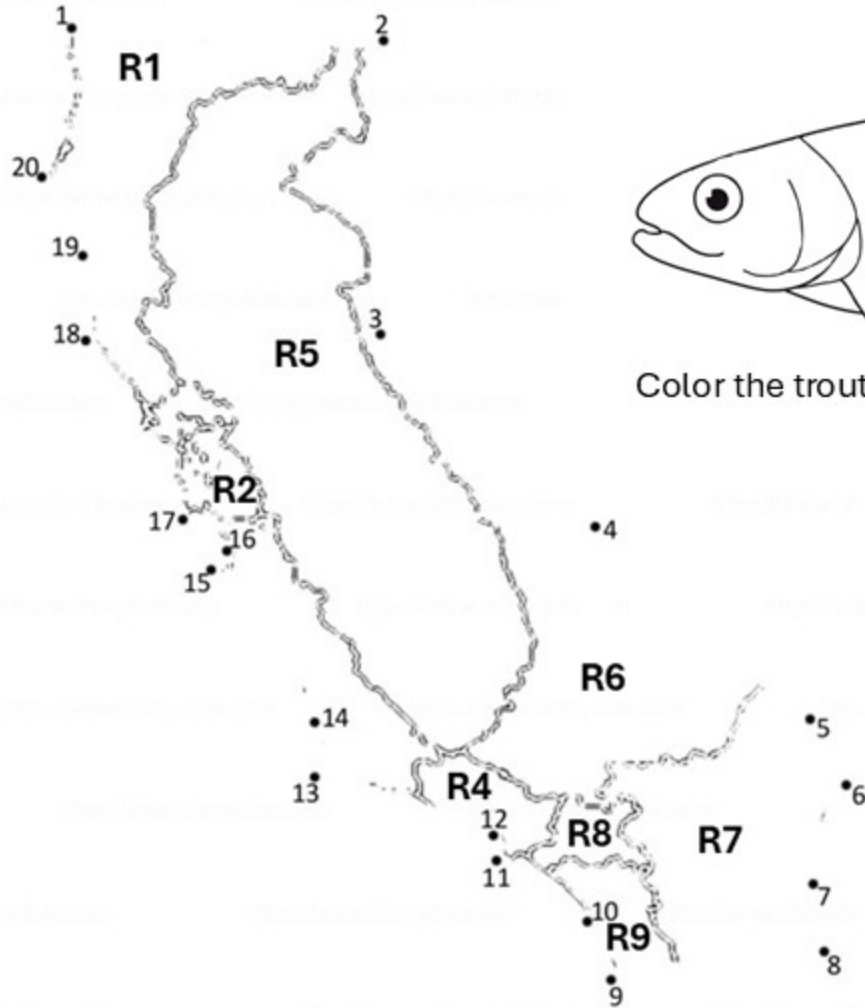


You Can Become a Champion for California's Waters
