Request for Comment Period Extension on the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Proposed Revisions, Federal Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 303(d) List of Water Quality Limited Segments For California


The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (Metropolitan) requests that the comment period for the SWRCB's proposed revisions to the CWA Section 303(d) List be extended. With the Southern California workshop just recently held in Pasadena on January 5, 2006, insufficient time is left for interested stakeholders to adequately review all the SWRCB documents and data, and evaluate comments received at the workshop before the official comment period ends on January 17, 2006.

Metropolitan, our Member Agencies, and other affected stakeholders need additional time to effectively evaluate the information regarding the Section 303(d) List revisions that directly affect the management and use of drinking water reservoirs and lakes in California. As public drinking water reservoir owners/operators, Metropolitan and our Member Agencies need to fully evaluate the proposed 303(d) Listings before submitting detailed comments to assist the SWRCB in accurate listing determinations.
