NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will accept comments on the proposed underground storage tank (UST) case closure for former Los Angeles County Department of Public Works, Case No. TT009625-009452. The State Water Board became the lead regulatory agency for this site during July 2013.

The Executive Director is authorized to close a UST case if it is determined that corrective action has been completed in accordance with Health and Safety Code section 25296.10.

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25296.10, the State Water Board Executive Director will be considering this UST case closure Order.

State Water Board UST Cleanup staff has completed a review of the case identified above, determined that the case meets the all the required criteria of State Water Board Resolution 92-49, and made a recommendation to the Executive Director for UST case closure. The recommendation is based upon the facts and circumstances of this particular UST case. The UST case record that is the basis for determining compliance with the State Water Board Resolution is available on the State Water Board's GeoTracker database.
