

In view of these facts and in consideration of the fact that under any permits issued the protestants will be adequately protected by the granting clause "subject to existing rights" and no diversions will be authorized by any permits issued which will deplete the supply of water to prior appropriators and riparian owners possessed of valid and existing rights, whether the right be one which is presently enjoyed to its full extent or one which is in process of completion by increasing utilization, the opinion is reached that as against these protestants, permits under these applications should be granted.

O R D E R

Applications for permits to appropriate water having been filed with the Division of Water Rights as entitled above, protests to the granting of such permits having been received, a public hearing having been held thereon, briefs having been waived, the matter having been submitted and the Division of Water Rights being now fully informed in the matter:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that permits be granted under each and all of the applications herein considered, the permits to contain such of the usual terms and conditions as may be appropriate.
