O P I N I O N

On July 25, 1923, Samuel J. Dunaway, Alvin Smith and Tony Kenney filed their application No. 3548 for a permit to appropriate unappropriated water from Buzzard Creek, in Siskiyou County, for use for power development. Thereafter protest was filed by the Skookum Placer Mining Association and in due course the matter of this application came on for hearing before the Division of Water Rights.


At the hearing the applicants stated that this application had been abandoned and that an engine would be used to supply power to the proposed project.

**ORDER**

Application No. 3548 for a permit to appropriate water having been filed with the Division of Water Rights as above stated, protest having been filed, a public hearing having been held and the Division of Water Rights now being fully informed in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that permit be and the same is hereby refused on Application No. 3548 and that said application be and the same is hereby rejected.
