O P I N I O N

This application was filed October 26, 1925, completed in accordance with the Water Commission Act and the requirements of the Rules and Regulations of the Division of Water Rights and protested by R. F. Garner and R. F. Garner, Jr. Being protested a hearing was set in the Council Chamber of the City Hall at San Bernardino at 10:00 o'clock a.m. on Wednesday, September 1, 1926. Of this hearing applicant and protestant were duly advised.

At the hearing Miss E. A. Hamilton stated that she was acting on behalf of and with full cognizance of her father, the applicant, and withdrew the application from the records of the Division of Water Rights. Action in accordance with this request may be taken without consideration of the issue raised in the protest.

Under date of September 24, 1926 applicant was asked to provide definite advice if he had decided to abandon the application. No answer to


letter has been received and this silence on applicant's part is interpreted to indicate his willingness that the application be cancelled.
