OPINION

Under Application 9799, which was filed with the Division on January 4, 1940, it was proposed to appropriate 0.12 c.f.s. from Niggerhead Creek in Tulare County to be diverted from March 1 to Movember 30 for the irrigation of 10 acres of general crops. Both the point of diversion and place of use

were described as being within the SE_{\pm}^{1} of SE_{\pm}^{1} of Section 26, T. 1 S., R. 25 E., M.D.B.& M.

Application 9799 was protested by E. A. Sorensen and by Henry A. Collin and Elsie M. Collin and being protested was set for public hearing in accordance with Section la of the Mater Commission Act on Monday, February 3, 1941 at 10:00 o'clock A.M. in the Legion Room of the Civic Auditorium, Visalia, California. Of this hearing applicant and protestants were duly notified.

Subsequent to the hearing, action was delayed in order to afford the interested parties an opportunity to install an appropriate measuring device by means of which reliable information relative to the runoff of the creek could be obtained upon which this office could base a decision. Apparently, however, the measuring device has not been installed and on June 16, 1942 a request was received from the applicant that Application 9799 be cancelled.

ORDER

Application 9799 for a permit to appropriate water having been filed with the Division of Water Resources as above stated, protests having been received, a public hearing having been held, subsequent to which the applicant requested cancellation of the application;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application 9799 be denied and the said application be cancelled upon the records of the Division.
