## OPINION

Application 11288 having been filed and a protest against approval thereof having been received, was regularly set for a field investigation of which applicant and protestants were duly notified and did agree, by signed stipulations, to abide by the report and subsequent findings of said investition.

The report of the investigation indicates that, as the result of a conference, the protestants were agreeable to withdrawal of their protest if applicant would reduce the amount sought under Application 11288 to 175 gallons per day.

Applicant did, on August 11, 1947, file a written authorization to change the amount sought under Application 11288 to 175 gallons per day and the application was so amended and protestants did, on August 19, 1947, file a written request for withdrawal of their protest on the condition that the application be so amended. There would now appear to be no bar to approval of Application 11288 and since the uses to which applicant proposes to put the waters sought are beneficial ones, it is the opinion of the State Engineer that said application should be approved subject to the usual terms and conditions.

# ORDER

Application 11288 for a permit to appropriate water having been filed with the Division of Water Resources as above stated, a protest having been filed, a field investigation having been made, a stipulated hearing having been held in accordance with Article 13, Section 733b of the California Administrative Code and the State Engineer now being fully informed in the premises:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application 11288 be approved for the amended amount and for the season of use applied for and that a permit be issued subject to such of the usual terms and conditions as may be appropriate.
