

of water under the permits by users other than from any of the four intakes named in Decision 1030, no statement has been filed with the Board either identifying the location of the points of diversion of said users or of the quantity of water used therefrom. Although the Mendocino District reported use of water under Permits 12947 and 12948 through 1963, this District likewise has not complied with the provisions of said condition 3. No progress report has been filed on behalf of the Mendocino District since 1963.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a hearing be scheduled at an early date to afford the permittees an opportunity to explain why said condition 3 of Decision 1030 has not been complied with and to present a satisfactory plan for accounting for use of project water by individual users, not only for the Coyote Valley Project, but for the Dry Creek Project, as well.
